Justice Madlanga has delivered many landmark judgments on administrative law and social justice, advancing the right to equality and socio-economic rights. One of his key judgments includes *Daniels v Scribante and Another* on the balancing of rights between farm tenants and owners. He also represented South Africa at the International Court of Justice in The Hague, Netherlands. Justice Madlanga was an evidence leader at the Marikana Commission of Inquiry, which investigated the deaths of people during wage-related protests in Marikana, North West.
