A universal basic income guarantee (UBIG) is one of the best tools available to reduce poverty, hunger, and destitution. South Africa has persistent and increasing unemployment and a large social protection gap excluding income support to those aged 18–59 years. In this webinar, we launch the IEJ's policy brief which puts forward proposals for the design of a UBIG. Research conducted by the IEJ shows that with smart, but relatively minor modifications to our tax system, a UBIG can be financed.
