Guidelines for Papers and Presentations

Papers

1. Word count

- a. Word Count 6 000 12 000 words, including footnotes and excluding the bibliography.
- 2. Style and layout For more information, please refer to the Stellenbosch University Law Faculty Writing Guide by clicking HERE¹. The link is also available on the footnote below.
 - a. Headings (use for all headings, including sub-headings)

Font: Arial Size: 12

Line spacing: 1.5

Alignment: Justified

- Indentation: Used only to align subsequent lines of heading text (i.e., "hanging indent").
- Paragraph spacing: 12pt before and 6pt after.

b. Main text

Font: Arial Size: 12

Line spacing: 1.5 Alignment: Justified

First line indentation: 0.5 (every paragraph, does not apply to headings).

c. Footnotes

Font: Arial Size: 10

Line spacing: 1.0 Alignment: Justified

Indentation: Used only to align subsequent lines of footnote text (i.e., hanging indent)

d. Separate quotations

Font: Arial Size: 11

Line spacing: 1.0

- Indentation: First and subsequent lines of text are left indented
- Paragraph spacing: 6pt after last line of text.
